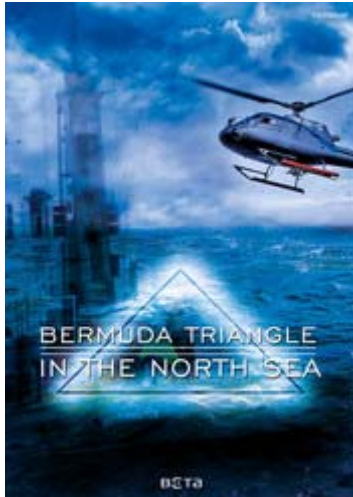

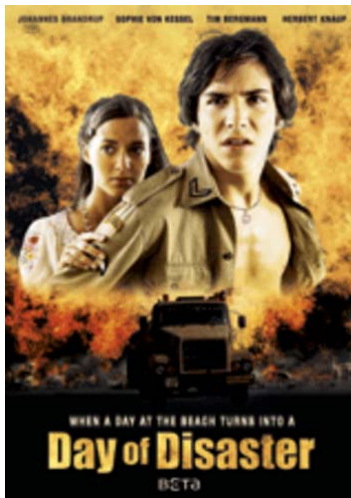

It's feeding time!

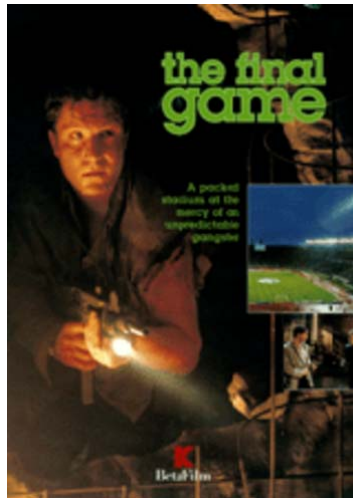

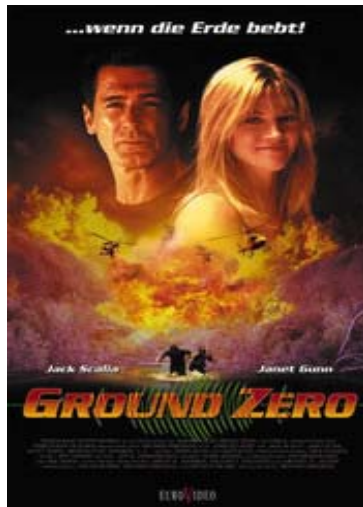

Hindenburg - The Last Flight

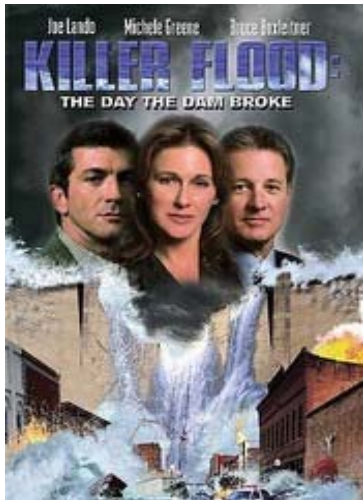
Fast, deadly, and everywhere...

Lightning: Bolts Of Destruction



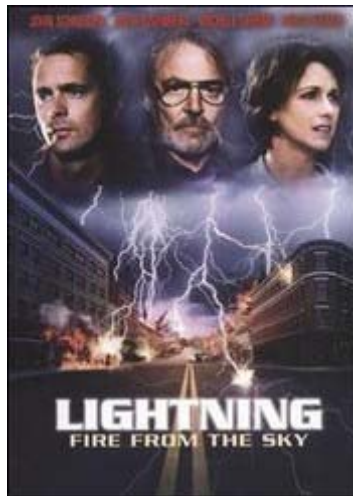
When the earth is enveloped by a deadly global lightning storm, a family of unlikely heroes must pull together and heal themselves in the process.

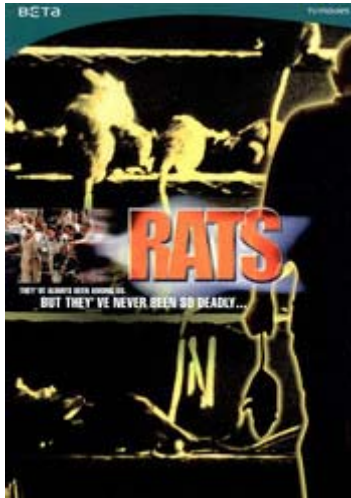
The island is infested with giant baboons that savagely attack in droves and kill viciously on sight.

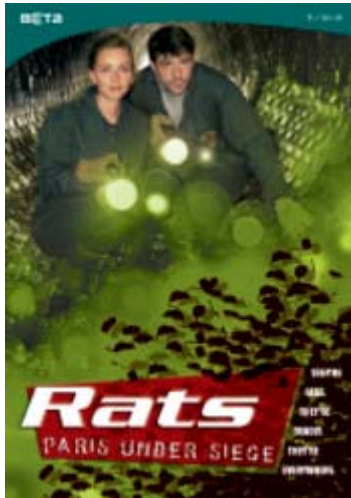

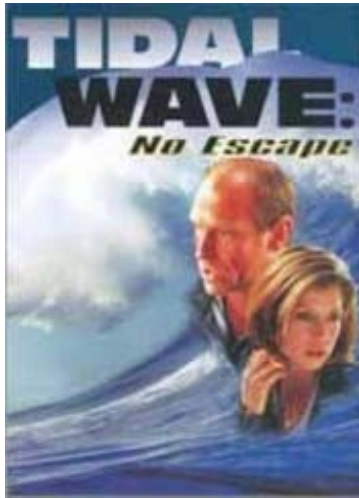
