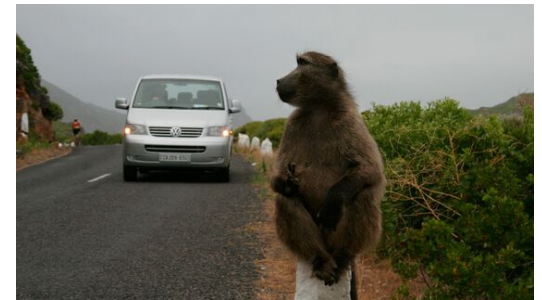
You thought they were far away, in the wild. Wrong. They're here; the urban invaders!
