Despite the enemy claiming to be the second largest army in the world, Ukraine resisted and is still standing.







The bust of Queen Nefertiti is a magnet for every visitor to Berlin. On the Nile, however, the icon of Egyptian culture is sorely missed.

As early as 1924, the effigy of the Queen was reclaimed.
